

## “Frozen” Scrapbook Page

### Materials:

- Marvy® Clever Lever Silhouette Craft Punch (Snowflake)
- Marvy® Paper Trimming Buddy with straight blade
- Marvy® Squishy Scissors
- Marvy® Corner Rounder
- Striped patterned paper—SEI
- Dotted patterned paper—SEI
- Red card stock
- Blue card stock
- White velvet paper
- Clear letter stickers—Creative Imaginations
- Colorbox Chalk Ink (Midnight)—Clearsnap Inc.
- Paper Adhesive—Helmar 450 Quick Dry
- Dimensional Adhesive—Helmar Liquid Scrap Dots



### Instructions:

All measurements are in inches.

1. Cut red card stock to 10.5" x 10" and use corner rounder to trim left edges. Attach to striped paper base, aligning right edges.
2. Cut 0.5" x 10.5" strip dotted paper. Attach to lower portion of red card stock, and trim excess using Squishy Scissors. Cut tag shape from blue card stock, ink edges, and layer over dotted stripe. Cut 0.25" x 8" strip blue card stock and layer over tag and dotted stripe.
3. Attach photo over paper strips and tag using paper adhesive.
4. Print journaling onto blue card stock and cut into strips using Paper Trimming Buddy. Ink edges, and layer over bottom right of photo and tag. Attach using paper adhesive. Apply letter stickers to form title along left edge of photo.
5. Use Clever Lever Silhouette snowflake punch to punch 5 snowflakes from white velvet paper and separate centers. Using dimensional adhesive, attach one large snowflake to top right of red card stock overlapping edge, and trim excess using Squishy Scissors. Attach one large snowflake to bottom right corner of photo, and remaining snowflakes along left side of red card stock using dimensional adhesive.
