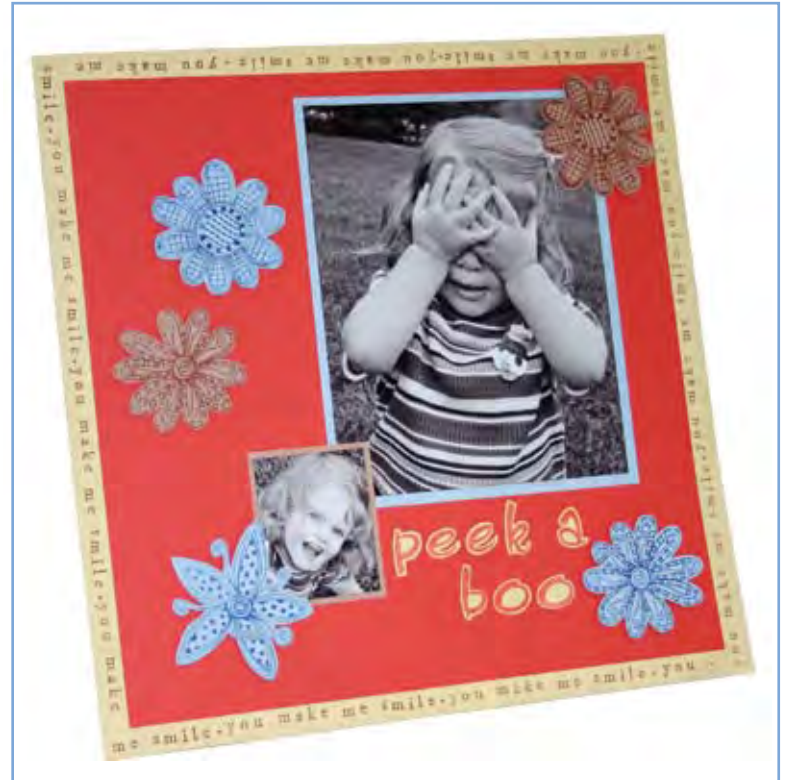


“Peek-a-boo” Scrapbook Page

Materials:

- Marvy® Clear Stamp Brush Markers - Brown, Blue
- Marvy® Clear Stamp LePlume II Marker - Red
- Marvy® Paper Trimming Buddy
- Marvy® Squishy Scissors
- Phrase stamp—Stampin’ Up
- Flower stamps—Cornish Heritage Farms
- Letter stamps—Technique Tuesday
- Light blue, light yellow (2), light brown, and red card stock
- Premium Craft Glue and Liquid Scrap Dots-Helmar Adhesives
- 5” x 7” and 2.5” x 3” black and white photos

**Instructions:**

All measurements are in inches.

1. Use Brown Brush Marker to ink phrase stamp, and stamp image on lower left corner of one sheet yellow card stock base. Repeat stamping of phrase around perimeter of card stock, keeping stamped image within ½” of paper edge.
2. Cut red card stock to 11”x11” using Paper Trimming Buddy. Glue to center of yellow stamped base using Premium Craft Glue.
3. Use Brown Brush Marker to darken edge of photos. Mat large photo onto blue card stock and small photo onto brown card stock, leaving 3/16” border. Glue large photo to top right of red card stock. Glue small photo, overlapping bottom left corner of large photo.
4. Stamp one of each flower onto blue card stock, using Blue Brush Marker to ink stamps. Cut out each stamped design using Squishy Scissors.
5. Stamp one of each rounded flower onto brown card stock, using Brown Brush Marker to ink stamps. Cut out each stamped design using Squishy Scissors.
6. Stamp title letters onto yellow card stock using Red LePlume II Marker to ink stamps. Cut out individual letters with Squishy Scissors and glue under large photo using Premium Craft Glue.
7. Apply Liquid Scrap Dots to underside of stamped flowers and attach in positions shown in project photo. Press in place gently until desired dimension is reached.
